\*The Secret Trial Five are five Muslim men who have collectively been held in Canadian prisons, often in solitary confinement, without charge or bail, on secret "evidence" neither they nor their lawyers are allowed to see, for 104 months. They are Mohammad Mahjoub (October 2000), Mahmoud Jaballah (August, 2001), Hassan Almrei (October 19, 2001), Mohamed Harkat (December 10, 2002) and Adil Charkaoui (May, 2003). Almrei has been in solitary confinement for two full years and has been on hunger strike since Sept. 29 to demand he get heat in his freezing cell.
